J. Call to Order-

K. Consent Agenda-

Lab Update/Fee Increase

Environmental Health Manager, Jason Kloss, came forward with a lab update and fee increase proposal for 2025. Kloss stated that the fee for Nitrate test was last increased in 2015 and the Coliform Bacteria test was last increased in 2023. The costs of lab supplies continue to increase. He proposed the change for Nitrate to go from \$20.00 to \$25.00 and for all ten tests to be ran went from \$140.00 to \$150.00. Coliform Bacteria will remain the same at \$25.00 per test. Kloss stated that a lot of the testing needs to be done within a 24 hour window and the closest testing site is New Ulm, MN. Motion by Commissioner Burger, second by Commissioner Wildermuth to approve the lab fee increases. The Motion carried unanimously.

Chairperson Welgraven asked if there was anything further to bring to the Board. Hearing nothing, he adjourned the meeting at 9:58 am.
