F. Financial -

Director Wilms asked Sarah Kirchner, Fiscal manager, to come forward and present the financials. The month of February started out with a beginning balance in checking of \$598,327.24 and ended at \$1,725,942.67. I transferred \$1,500,000 from savings on 2/7/2020. This leaves \$887,798.96 in Bremer savings. I anticipate that I will need to move funds from MAGIC in the next month or so. We ended February with an overall cash & investment balance of \$5,244,836.41. When excluding the designated funds, the ending balance for the month was \$3,823,935.00, which is a little lower than last year at this time. The self-insurance fund was at \$1,108,165 as of February 28th, 2020. As of today that fund balance is \$ 1,055,272.00. Fund Balances: Fund 01 (PH) \$2,029,158.92, Fund 05 (HS) 1,794,776.37. Now looking at the numbers from a budget perspective. Ending February Public Health was 4% OVER budget for revenues. We have received 1st quarter levy funding from all 6 counties. PH was 1% OVER budget for expenditures. I would still attribute that to having paid liability insurance at first of year. Overall the revenues are exceeding expenses by \$118,161.50. Ending February Human Services was 6% UNDER budget for revenues. Contributions from counties (Levy) and intergovernmental revenues will remain light through the first quarter. HS was 1% OVER budget for expenditures. We have already received 3 of the 5 vans that were approved to order in January. I have been working on the logistics of getting them road ready and we are excited for our staff to get them on the road. Motion made by Anderson second by Nath: To approve the complete agenda and Board minutes as presented.
