J. Call to Order

K. Consent Agenda-

Chairperson Wakefield asked if there were any additions to the agenda. Wakefield stated that we have an addition to the agenda. We are adding an Opioid Settlement Update. Wakefield asked if anyone had a conflict of interest to identify. None were identified. He asked if there were any correction or additions to the minutes of the March 15, 2023 meeting. Motion by D. L. Financial -

Chairperson Wakefield stated the Financials had been received during the Human Services Board, and will be moved to the Governing Board.

M. Caseload-

Director Wilms asked if there were any comments or concerns regarding the caseload. None were stated.

N. Discussion/Information-

- 1. Opioid Settlement Update Ann Orren
 - Ann Orren stated that a lot of time has been spent on logistics of this since it was for 18 years. This was done for the spirit of the money being used in the community. A. Orren stated that they wanted to make sure it was a true voice of the community. Realize it is resources and assessments within our communities. We really want to make sure we have a full picture of what we have in our counties and what we need in each county. The first two meetings were held in Marshall and Slayton. The group discussions were helpful. Talked about the strategies in prevention, harm reduction, criminal Justice, treatment/recover, and other. Other would be training and education. Now they are looking at putting together guidelines or bylaws for the upcoming meetings. They want to make sure they are being transparent and equitable with where the funding is going and benefits of those funds. Each county has gotten at least two payments from distributors and five payments from Jansen and Jansen. There should be additional settlements moving forward.
- 2. Southwest MN Healthy Community Survey Carol Biren
 The Southwest MN Healthy Community Survey was started back in December. Two
 thousand surveys/county in all sixteen counties were sent out. C. Biren stated that she had
 asked for \$60,000 from the board earlier in the year but there is an infrastructure grant that
 will now help with funding of this survey. Twenty percent is being paid for by covid funds
 and rest will be paid for by the infrastructure grant. Advertising will be going out this week.
 Please share if you see on facebook so that people will fill out the surveys. Really excited
 about the data we will get from these surveys. The two thousand mailings in each county
 were done on a random mailing list.
