# K. Consent Agenda-

#### O. Decision Items-

- 1. 2024 Public Health Fee Schedule
  - Carol Biren brought forward a couple of small changes to the fee schedule including depression screening and the car seat education. She stated we recieve just enough of what the insurance pays for so will be increasing them slightly. First Aid and CPR we do have staff trained for that and we will just fill some gaps in the community that don't have those resources. Motion to approve 2024 fee schedule made by Commissioner Burger, second by Commissioner Salfer. The motion carried unanimously.
- 2. 2024 Public Health Budget

Lisa DeBoer presented the budget information regarding levy amounts and program information for 2024. Motion by Commissioner Anderson, second by Commissioner Wildermuth to approve a one-time levy decrease to a per capita rate of \$12.00 for a total levy request of \$883,692 for a public health budget of \$4,818,453 for 2024. The motion carried unanimously.

Chairperson Wakefield asked if there was anything further to bring to the Board. Hearing nothing, he adjourned the meeting at 10:30am.
