Ann Orren, Health Educator Supervisor, came forward to present the Board with E-cigs and new products being sold. Orren had various products she showed the Board and how they are being used by under age children. They are a battery powered device that deliver nicotine in the form of an aerosol. Nicotine levels are very rarely accurate to what they label for these products. Orren also informed the Board of the adverse effects to minors who use these products such as altering the brains chemistry, also they are more likely to use other substances. The Agency is educating parents, school districts, and health care providers on these products as well as offering free quit smoking resources. Also, the Agency is working with establishments on becoming free-smoking areas including E-cigs.
